Happy 1,991st Birthday!

OK, you read that right. Christ's one, holy, catholic and apostolic church is turning 1,991 this upcoming June 9th. In celebration of that special day, I am encouraging both Messiah and St. Stephen's folks to wear red. (In GBR country that should not be hard – right?)

So what does this mean? Why does the Universal Church have a birthday? In the year 28 CE (AD), the church gathered nine days after Jesus ascended into Heaven. Jesus had told them, "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem (their own neighborhood), in all Judea (their own country), and to all the ends of the earth. The church was together, in one place, and the Holy Spirit gave ability to speak other languages needed for ministering in other parts of the world. The spark that was needed to bring the Good News to the whole world was given at nine o'clock that morning and continues even today. We celebrate the very first day of the Church's existence – and its calling to go out into the world.

Pentecost – the Church's birthday, is also about receiving from God exactly what we need to do the work of ministry. The gifts, the power, and the resources all come from God, all we need to do is to conform our minds to what the Spirit is saying to the churches. For us in Shared Ministry, there is now a double meaning to Pentecost Sunday because the Spirit's strengthening of either church is a blessing and empowerment to the other.

So wish each other Happy Birthday. Enjoy the birthday cake after services, and pray that we can reach others, in "Jerusalem" (our neighborhood), in "Judea" (Nebraska), and the ends of the earth.

Members Present: Theresa Burson, Jeff Koch, Jim Elrod, Alice Elstermeier, Brenda Kucera, Linell Schultz, Jim Fandry and Fr. Robert Lewis.

Members Absent: Erich Fruehling

Call to Order/Agenda: Theresa Burson called the meeting to order and reviewed the agenda. Brenda Kucera moved to accept the agenda, second by Jim Elrod. Carried.

Devotions: Jim Elrod read the 23rd Psalm and reminded us to let the Spirit be our guide. A religious person will do what he is told, no matter what is right. Whereas a spiritual person will do what is right, no matter what he is told.

Prayers: Prayers were raised up by Fr. Robert for: Stu Kucera, Blakely and Lexi Pacheco,

Correspondence: Jeff advised us that Zach Kneale sent a thank you card in appreciation for the scholarship he received.

Personnel Update: Ralph Engelhardt gave an update on the Administrative Clerical Position. They are waiting for resumes from two employment agencies, and then will be setting up interviews to hire a temp to fill the position being vacated by Cheryl Harder's retirement.

Financial Reports: Report is on file. Karen Niedfelt presented and discussed the April Financial reports. Weekly offerings YTD are \$76,860.07. Karen noted that the Goettsch fund CD's were renewed at higher interest rates than in the past.

Update on refurbishing hand bells: Linell Schultz and Jeff Koch gave an estimated cost of \$2,772 which includes \$270 for shipping for the maintenance needed for the hand bells. Karen Niedfelt recommended that the money for repairs be taken from designated funds. Jeff made a motion to contact the company to have the hand bells sent in this summer. Second by Theresa Burson. Carried.

Vestry & Council are invited to Koch's farm June 9th: (Note the change of date to June 9th) around 2 pm to for games, networking, etc. Hamburgers will go on the grill about 4 pm. Bring a side dish.

Motion to accept reports: Jeff Koch moved to approve reports. Second by Alice Elstermeier. Carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Potluck luncheon for Cheryl Harder after worship service on June 2nd. Outreach/Social Ministry committee will meet after worship on Sunday, May 19th to make plans for the luncheon.
- Fr. Robert has tried to reach out to the Pastor Sheri Lodel at Dannebrog to see what their needs are with the flood damage to Our Savior's Lutheran Church. Fr. Robert will continue to attempt to make contact to get information. Outreach/Social Ministry Committee had previously suggested making "God's Work-Our Hands" a fundraiser for Our Savior's, Dannebrog.
- Need to have a joint meeting with Council & Vestry around the 6-month time frame to talk about the shared pastoral duties, and how it is working out for both churches.
- Brenda Kucera reported that the Ministry Site Profile (MSP) is nearing completion. A first draft was sent to Karen for financial and compensation information. We can start planning a meeting with the Call Committee candidates, to make sure they can support the mission and vision documented in the MSP.
- Theresa Burson asked the Property Committee to check on repairs for the kitchen refrigerator, or look into purchasing a replacement. The refrigerator has an internal leak, and it is causing a bad odor.
- Jim Elrod explained that Heather Lessig from Goodwill Greater Nebraska would like to do cooking classes with their clients at Messiah on Wednesdays from 1:15 to 2:15 pm. Jim moved that we allow the cooking classes to proceed. Second by Theresa Burson. Carried.

Next Special Meeting: Wednesday, May 29th at 6:30 pm to finish working on the Ministry Site Profile and review the document with the candidates for the Call Committee.

Other Business / Announcements: Next Meeting is June 10, 2019 @ 7 PM. Deadline for agenda items is June 5th / Devotions by Erich Fruehling

Motion to Adjourn by Jeff Koch. Second by Linell Schultz. Carried. Closed with the Lord's Prayer.
