

COVID-19 Health & Safety Guidelines for Worship at Messiah

Welcome back, everyone!

- Please enter at the main south entrance when attending worship.
- Please wear a mask while entering the church. If you do not have one, masks are available at the entrance.
- Masks are to be worn at all times during the worship service—including while singing hymns and speaking the confession, responsive reading, Apostles' Creed, and the Lord's Prayer.
- Please use good hand washing practices. Hand sanitizer is available in the narthex.
- Offering plates are available in the narthex to be used at your convenience. They will not be passed during the service.
- To maintain recommended social distancing, congregants will be ushered to and from designated seats. Households are asked to sit together.
- On communion Sundays, the ushers will hand out pre-packaged communion at the entrance. Following worship, congregants are asked to take their empty cups with them and dispose of them as they exit the church.
- There will not be any organized fellowship in the basement.
- If you or anyone in your household is experiencing a fever or cough, or if you feel for any reason that you would be putting yourself or others at risk by attending worship, please stay home. Be safe, be courteous, be well.
